the Jew are not about to take over the world

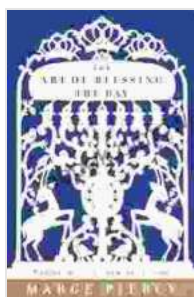

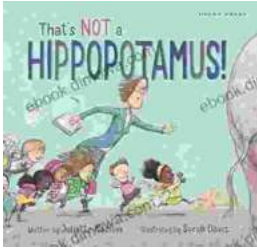

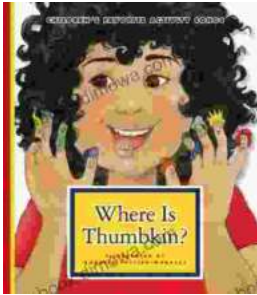
